## **“Make It Happen” Ben Glattstein Scholarship**

### Purpose and Amount of the Scholarship

In Memory of our member and friend Ben Glattstein, ESA awards this scholarship to a member that has shown continuous and tireless support of our operations. The Make It Happen award shall recognize an individual who would not hesitate to volunteer personal time and goes out of his or her way to make things happen.

The scholarship is awarded no more than once per calendar year.

The recipient receives a \$400 credit to be used with ESA. Funds may be used to pay for flight time in one or more of ESA’s divisions. If the candidate is a member of the Sport Aviation Club (SAC) at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University but not ESA, the funds can be used towards the membership fee to join ESA. No monetary funds are paid out directly to the recipient and use of flight or membership credit is tracked through our bookkeeping process on MyFBO. The scholarship credit must be used within 2 years before any unused funds become void. Scholarships are non-transferable.

### Publicity of Program

The Make It Happen scholarship is advertised and promoted through the ESA newsletter as well as at least at one general meeting.

### Eligibility

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, a candidate must be a current member of ESA and/or member of SAC. Candidates for this scholarship shall be recommended by other members of ESA and/or SAC. Self-nominations are not accepted. Members of ESA and/or SAC are not eligible for scholarships while serving as an officer. Members may receive more than one scholarship during their membership but a maximum of two per calendar year.

Activities that would be taken into consideration for selection would include: taking initiatives for projects, coordinating events, attending fund raisers, assisting with projects, maintenance and service duties, and other exceptional personal involvement.

### Application and Selection Process

Any current ESA and/or SAC member may recommend another ESA and/or SAC member for this scholarship.

The recommendation shall:

- Include a brief description of why they recommend the candidate for this award
- list activities where the candidate has demonstrated continuous involvement with ESA
- Highlight how this candidate stands out of the general ESA and/or SAC membership.

Applications and recommendations shall be sent by email or mail to the current ESA president and secretary.

Applications and recommendations must be received by midnight of the deadline date to be considered.

### Selection Criteria

The selection is based on the level of involvement the candidate has with ESA. Besides the participation level, other factors such as time as a member, fund raisers, volunteer duties, and other activities are considered.

The selection committee reserves the right to change the dollar amount and number of scholarships granted each year. The committee reserves the right not to issue the scholarship if the recommended candidates do not appear worthy of the award.
